
April 23 Divine Mercv



Pastoral Letter No. 26/2017 (Lent: 2017)

February 28, 2017

By the grace of God, Mar Jacob Angadiath, the Bishop of St. Thomas Syro Malabar Catholic Diocese of Chicago, send this greeting and message to all the priests, religious men and women and beloved people of God.

Dear and Rev. Fathers, Rev. Sisters and dear Faithful,

Once again we are in the period of Lent: a time to pray and fast, repent and confess our sins, find joy and grace in the Risen Lord. Let us reflect upon the words of the prophet Isaiah: "Lo, the hand of the Lord is not too short to save, nor his ear too dull to hear". The 26th workshop for Bishops, held in Dallas, on February 6-8, 2017 had the theme: "Healing Persons in a Wounded Culture". The world around us is wounded through sins of various forms. Violations of the Ten Commandments and the Commandments of the Church are truly serious sins. During this Lent let me propose ten issues that deserve our special attention, prayers and repentance:

- 1. Abortion: "Human life must be respected and protected absolutely from the moment of conception. "Before I formed you in the womb I knew you, and before you were born I consecrated you". (Jer 1:5) "You are precious in my eyes and glorious", says the Lord through the prophet Isaiah: 43:4"
- 2. Physician Assisted Suicide: This is another attack on human life. Physicians are expected to save life; but now they become agents of death.
- 3. Euthanasia (Mercy Killing): Natural death is the end of life; any other human intervention to cause death is wrong.
- 4. Pre-marital Sex: Another wide-spread evil is pre-marital sex. The greatest gift that a man and a woman can exchange on their wedding day will be the virtue of chastity. Any kind of sexual relationship is not expected among young people before marriage. Let young people enter into marriage with purity of body and soul
- 5. Same Sex Marriage: Homosexuality or lesbianism may be a tendency found among certain boys or girls. If they are properly guided and counseled these tendencies can be corrected. Homosexuality or lesbianism in itself is not a sin; but if it is activated through same sex marriage, then it becomes evil and a sin. The Church does not discriminate homosexual people but at the same time, the Church declares that all homosexual relations in any form are contrary to the order of creation.
- 6. Pornography: It presents significant pastoral and spiritual challenge against the virtue of chastity. Fighting pornography through chastity is both a personal and cultural task. Parents, teachers, priests and elders have to be very attentive towards our children and young people to save our future generation from this evil
- 7. Transgenderism: This is a complex situation. Any mutilation of the body is wrong. There will be enormous moral, anthropological, social and theological issues in dealing with transgenderism
- 8. Alcoholism: It is an addiction. The net result of alcoholism is the loss of body and soul.
- 9. Use of Drugs: Addiction to drugs leads to all kinds of social crimes, such as stealing, alcoholism, sexual promiscuity and untimely death. Dear parents and children let us avoid any contact with this deadly evil of our time.
- 10. Gambling: Frequent visits to casinos will end up at the loss of money and time and gradually our health and wealth will be gone and one day we will become like the product son.

YEAR OF YOUTH:

Remember, the Lord calls you and loves you, Children and Youth. Let this period of Lent be an occasion to build our relationship with one another through prayer, love and service.

FUN FACTS - DID YOU KNOW?

Tison Thomas

1. How many days Christ stayed in the Tomb?

Christ often said that He will resurrect after three days. Did it ever cross your mind why then Christ resurrected on early Sunday morning, in less than 72 hours? There are two explanations.

- Jews believe that when God created time, He first created night and then day. Therefore, a Jewish calendar date begins with the night beforehand. While a day in our calendar begins and ends at midnight, a Jewish day goes from nightfall to nightfall. Christ died on the cross on Friday during day, which is considered the first day. Christ stayed in the tomb on Saturday which started on Friday nightfall, the second day. The third day begins on the nightfall Saturday, which is considered the third day.
- Also, there is a traditional belief that Christ stayed in the tomb for 40 hours - from Friday through Sunday.

2. Why Jesus robe was seamless and what did it represent?

In the passion reading we read and hear that Jesus robe was seamless and the soldiers cast lots. Why the gospel writer specify it.

- · Within a theological perspective, the tunic represents Christ's Kingship and Priesthood. Kings and Priests wear the long tunics as was the custom at that time.
- Also, as the legend says, in those days, 2000 years ago, clothes were not readily available, so when people use these thick materials, they use it for life. When people grow taller or bigger, they stitch additional clothing materials to the existing cloth. Tradition says that the robe Mary stitched for Jesus grows with him and is why it is seamless. The robe miraculously grows with Jesus.

SACRED TRIDUUM

Sundown on Holy Thursday to sundown on Easter Sunday is considered the most solemn occasion of our Christian life. This three-day period is referred to as the Easter Triduum, also known as the Sacred Triduum, or Paschal Triduum. Triduum is a Latin word, formed from the Latin prefix tri- (meaning "three") and the Latin word dies ("day"). A triduum is a three-day period of prayer, usually in preparation for an important feast or in celebration of that feast, which we celebrate as the final three days of Lent and Holy Week. These three days starts with the celebration of our Lord's Supper and ends with Easter Celebration.

The Sacred Triduum, reminds us to contemplate the revelation of God's infinite mercy in the events of Jesus' passion, death and resurrection. Holy Thursday, Jesus gives Himself to us as food and, in the washing of feet, teaches us the need to serve others. On Good Friday we contemplate the divine love which embraces all mankind. Holy Saturday, the day of God's silence, invites us not only to solidarity with all who are abandoned and alone, but also to trust in that faithful love which turns death into life. Since Easter represents the fulfillment of God's promises to mankind, it is the most important holiday on the Christian calendar. The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches us "Easter is not simply one feast among others, but the "Feast of feasts," the "Solemnity of solemnities," just as the Eucharist is the "Sacrament of sacraments".
